Cross Compliance Key Dates



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Do you know your Cross Compliance dates?

January

- 1st Start of the cross compliance year. Cross compliance rules must be met from this date (All SMRs and GAECs).
- 1st No cultivations and application of pesticides can be made within two metres of the top of the bank of a watercourse from this date (GAEC 1).
- 1st No cultivations and application of pesticides can be made within two metres of the centre line of a hedge from this date (GAEC 7).
- 1st Organic manure with a high available N content (e.g. slurry, poultry manures or liquid digested sewage sludge) can be applied to grassland and other land on shallow or sandy soils from this date. Note: quantitative restrictions apply until 14th February (SMR 1).
- 1st Start of quantitative restriction period for the application of organic manures with a high available N content on grassland and other land on sandy or shallow soils (SMR 1).

February

- 1st Organic manure with a high available N content can be applied to grassland and other land on soils that are not sandy or shallow from this date. Note: quantitative restrictions apply until 14th February (SMR 1).
- 1st Start of quantitative restriction period for the application of organic manures with a high available N content on grassland and other land on soils that are not sandy or shallow (SMR 1).
- 14^{th} End of the quantitative restriction period for the application of organic manures with a high available N content (SMR 1).
- 16th Chemical or manufactured N fertilisers can be applied to grassland and other land in all NVZ areas, except Moray, Aberdeenshire, Banff and Buchan NVZ areas from this date (SMR 1).
- 21st Chemical or manufactured N fertilisers can be applied to grassland and other land in Moray, Aberdeenshire, Banff and Buchan NVZ areas from this date (SMR 1).







March

- 1st Fertiliser and Manure Management Plan must be prepared and implemented before this date (SMR 1).
- 1st Scrub and/or gorse must not be removed or burned from this date (SMR 2).
- 1st Hedges must not be trimmed or branches lopped off trees from this date (except for road safety reasons). Note: hedge laying can still be carried out (SMR 2; GAEC 7).

April

- 1st Hedge laying must not be carried out from this date (SMR 2; GAEC 7).
- 16th Muirburn must not be carried out from this date (except if a licence has been granted for out of season burning) (SMR 2; GAEC 6).

July

1st Start of quantitative restriction period for the application of organic manures with a high available N content on other land on sandy or shallow soils (SMR 1).

August

- 1st Start of quantitative restriction period for the application of organic manures with a high available N content on grassland on sandy or shallow soils (SMR 1).
- 1st Start of the closed period for applying organic manure with a high available N content to other land on shallow or sandy soils; except if a cereal crop is sown on or before 15 September or oilseed rape, catch or cover crops are sown on or before 30th September (SMR 1).
- 1st Hedges or trees can be trimmed or cut from this date if the hedge or tree is in a field that will be sown in oilseed rape or temporary grass within the month (SMR 2; GAEC 7).

September

- 1st Hedges can be trimmed and branches lopped off trees from this date (SMR 2; GAEC 7).
- 1st Scrub and/or gorse can be removed or burned from this date (SMR 2).
- 1st Start of quantitative restriction period for the application of organic manures with a high available N content on other land on soils that are not sandy or shallow (SMR 1).
- 1st Start of closed period for applying organic manure with a high available N Content to grassland on sandy or shallow soils (SMR 1).
- 1st Start of closed period for applying chemical N fertiliser to other land in all the NVZ areas (SMR 1).
- 15th Start of quantitative restriction period for the application of organic manures with a high available N content on grassland on soils that are not sandy or shallow (SMR 1).
- 15th Start of closed period for applying chemical N fertilisers to grassland in all NVZ areas (SMR 1).
- 16th Start of closed period for applying organic manure with a high available N content to other land on sandy or shallow soils that have been sown with a cereal crop before this date (SMR 1).

October

- 1st Muirburn can be undertaken from this date (SMR 2; GAEC 6).
- 1st Start of closed period for applying organic manure with a high available N content to other land on sandy or shallow soils that have been sown with oilseed rape, catch or cover crops before this date (SMR 1).
- 1st Start of closed period for applying organic manure with a high available N to other land on soils that are not sandy or shallow (SMR 1).
- 15th Start of closed period for applying organic manure with a high available N content to grassland on soils that are not sandy or shallow (SMR 1).

December

- 23rd Annual inventory of sheep and goats must be returned by this date (SMR 8).
- 31st Water abstraction data returns must be submitted to SEPA by this date (GAEC 2).
- 31st End of the cross compliance year. Cross compliance rules must be met until this date (All SMRs and GAECs).
