Limekilns – Farm Background



- Family farm partnership Alistair & Alison
- Approx 480 acres.
- Dairy business: 220+ cows all year calving.
- Heifers reared as replacements.
- Summer: strip grazing system. Start buffer feeding in August.
- Winter: Cows housed fed TMR.
- Approx 80 acres barley and 30 acres wheat.
 25 acres potatoes. Remainder: TGRS / PGRS
