Practise: cleaning, handling procedure, spoons or raddles, veterinary treatment	
ster sugar or cold water on the prolapse helps encourage it back in	
ver (hypocalcaemia):	
Likelihood of problem based on calcium supplementation, signs: ewes affected have muscle weakness, lie on chest, head on ground, sometimes saliva drool, can be confused with twin lamb disease. Treatment protocol	
Twin lamb disease:	
Energy deficiency, similar signs to milk fever, treatment protocol	



Mastitis:

e.g.	Check udders after lambing, any culling identifiers such as tag notching, treat affected ewes
Other of	dominant issues on the farm:
e.g.	Liver fluke, Jaagsiekte (ovine pulmonary adenocarcinoma), Listeriosis. Signs and what to do.
