Mentoring for new entrants to farming

Up to 4 days one-to-one consultancy time with a personal mentor

Benefit from being paired with an experienced farmer in your sector, who can provide tailored support and advice on how to manage set up and grow your new farm or business. Typical skills that mentors offer include experience of running a farm business, traditional skills (e.g. stone walling and hedge laying), and food and drink industry experience.

Integrated Land Management Plans (ILMP)

Up to £1,200 per plan for expert consultancy

Undertake an independent and confidential assessment of your business with the help of an experienced farm business adviser of your choice who can identify your business's strengths, weaknesses and opportunities.

Specialist advice

Up to £1,000 funding for public good advice & £800 for business efficiency advice

Helps farmers take a deeper look at specific issues of concern or interest. As part of an ILMP, farmers can choose to benefit from two further specialist advice plans covering a range of topics – eight in total – including climate change adaptation and mitigation, biodiversity, and water pollution prevention and control.

Carbon audits

Request a fully funded carbon audit of your farm or croft to see where performance improvements and savings can be made, identify the efficiency with which resources are used and benchmark your business's performance so that you can compare it with that of similar businesses.
